- *Campaign* In the months leading up to the election, candidates participate in numerous events - speeches, debates, and engaging with the public - to attempt to win over more voters
- Issues Important topics or problems that candidates highlight to express their positions
- Empathetic Ability to understand and share the feelings of another
- Gender Gap The difference in access to opportunities, status, and attitudes between men and women
