Reminder: Change in Guidance on Counting Visits to American Spaces

Starting with the October 2022 reporting period, Spaces and posts should no longer include program attendees in their reported visits numbers. Please keep your visits and program attendee numbers separate in the future.

We are making this change for a few reasons:

- Separating the two totals will help us better analyze the visits stats.
- Better visits analysis will help us determine which Spaces have needs for new technology and additional print and electronic resources.
- This will also help us better understand how the visits numbers are compiled.

As mentioned in [the previous Data Digest](#), our new OASIS database will be launching next year, and we will be able to add the two totals together as needed.

Our goal is to make visits counts as consistent and as standardized as possible to make all of our American Spaces data as accurate as possible!
